MEN SEEKING SEXUAL INTEGRITY (MEN ONLY)

(Tuesdays 6:00 pm—7:30 pm)

This group is for the brave-hearted man who dares to take the journey in understanding his sexual addiction. The addiction starts with a lustful desire for pleasurable relief from inner emptiness or pain. Eventually the quest for relief becomes an addiction which replaces the pleasure with tension, depression, rage, guilt or even physical issues. The addiction can begin to take priority over everything, often creating an overwhelming loneliness because of the separation from God and loved ones. Through increased reliance on God and the support of the group, men begin to achieve sexual integrity and increased intimacy with loved ones.

GRIEF SUPPORT GROUP (MEN AND WOMEN)

(1st, 3rd, & 5th Thursday each month)

Are you suffering after the death of someone close to you? Grief is emotionally and physically painful. The pain is so deep that it can become overwhelming.
