REFUSE TO LOSE! (MEN AND WOMEN)

(Note: This group meets at 5:00 pm)

Declaring war on anxiety, depression and OC, Pastor Rudy leads a 5-session Bible Study using the Scriptures and a video session with Pastor and Author Levi Lusko. We will closely examine keys from the Bible on how to fight the internal struggles that keep us from experiencing all God wants for our lives. Sharing personal struggles with anxiety, depression and obsessive-compulsive disorder, Pastor Rudy will facilitate a safe place where participants can discover who they are, their unique calling from the Lord, and some practical ways to work through internal battles. It isn't a sin for Christians to struggle with anxiety and depression. The sin is when we allow these thieves to walk all over us.

GRIEF SUPPORT GROUP (MEN AND WOMEN)

Are you suffering after the death of someone close to you? Grief is emotionally and physically painful. The pain is so deep that it can become overwhelming. Why pretend that you are not experiencing terrible inner turmoil? Grief Support Group meetings are a place for you to rest and restore—a place to help those suffering find hope in their grief.

S.O.S. (Sharing Our Stories) (MEN AND WOMEN)

S.O.S. is a support group offering fellowship, hope, and encouragement to adults affected by loved ones struggling with substance abuse issues. In a confidential setting, seek support from others in similar situations. *You can* find comfort in the midst of difficult situations as well as practical help for the trials that go along with loving someone struggling with addiction.

LIFE RECOVERY—12-STEP (MEN AND WOMEN)

This group is for those whose life has been affected by substance abuse, violence, or other obsessive behavior. Through the use of Biblical principles, the purpose of this group is to allow God to restore your mental, physical, emotional, and spiritual health. This recovery support group will map out a journey of wholeness and proper dependence on God while creating a community of fellowship and love.

DIVORCE RECOVERY (MEN AND WOMEN)

DivorceCare takes a biblical approach to divorce, separation and related issues such as reconciliation, remarriage, forgiveness, and the effect of divorce on children and families. DivorceCare emphasizes that real healing from the intense pain of divorce must begin with a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

THE HIGHEST POWER (MEN ONLY)

Based on Luke 4:16-18, this men's group will focus on the scriptures and Jesus Christ who came to set the prisoners free, recover sight for the blind, and set the oppressed free.

GROWTH IN CHRIST (WOMEN ONLY)

A woman's group using scriptures and recovery tools (literature, phone, meetings, writing, prayer and meditation, steps, service, discipleship, action plan, anonymity) to grow closer to Jesus, one day at a time...

TAMAR Trusting the Almighty to Manifest Amazing Recoveries (WOMEN ONLY)

GROUND ZERO (TEENS)

Ground Zero is a support group offering fellowship, hope, and encouragement to teens affected by loved ones struggling with addiction issues. In a confidential setting with adult supervision, teens receive support from other teens in similar situations.
